

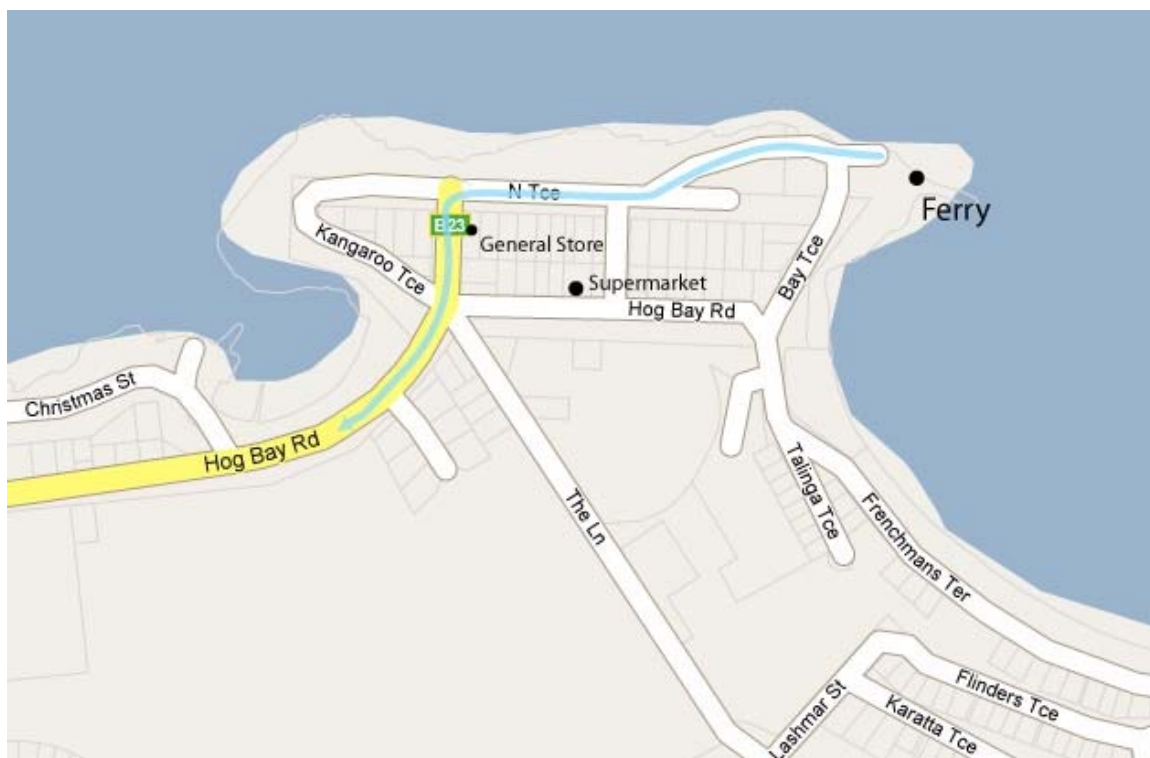
Directions to Middle River Lookout

The ferry to Kangaroo Island leaves from Cape Jervis which is on the southern tip of the Fleurieu Peninsula. Cape Jervis is just over 100 km from the centre of Adelaide via Main South Road. It is easy to find, just follow the signs and keep heading south. You should pass through Myponga and Yankalilla. Allow up to 2 hours for the drive, longer on long weekends. Remember that you need to arrive at the ferry at least 30 minutes prior to its departure.

The Ferry leaves from the end of Flinders Street in Cape Jervis. Once you reach Cape Jervis, keep heading toward the sea and you will eventually see a large sign saying “Sea Link Ferry.” Be sure to turn at the sign which is the second on you left, and not into the car park which is the first left after the no entry sign. If you turned at the right place you will go down a hill and see the waiting bays.

Once you are off the boat in Penneshaw, drive up the hill away from the ferry along North Terrace. At the end of the street you will have to turn left onto Hog Bay Road.

Once on Hog Bay Road there is a small general store on the left hand side which sells milk, bread, and pastries. The Penneshaw pub is on your right. There is a larger supermarket on the extension of Hog Bay Rd if you turn left again, where there is a larger range (see map). If you are after shops, the majority are in Kingscote, the largest town on the island. There is a general store in Parndana, which is the closest town to Middle River Lookout (34 km drive), but variety is limited.



When you reach the Y-junction on Hog Bay Road, head right and follow Hog Bay Road for approximately 47 km, when you will come to a T-junction. Turn right at the junction, and then take the first left which is only 200 metres down the road (signposted as Kingscote, Airport and Parndana). After turning left here, drive for another 5km (you will see the airport on your left) after which you will come to another T-junction.

Turn left at the T-junction and then right straight away onto the Playford Highway, following the sign that says Parndana. Follow this road for approximately 25 km until come to Parndana.

When you pass the Shell service station which will be on your right, reset the trip computer on your car. After 4.26 km, turn right onto Stokes Bay Road. It is the road just after the Parndana wildlife park.

After 12.08 km turn left onto Pratts Road (you will hit dirt on Stokes Bay Road after 1.73 km). There should be a box on the ground which says “eggs for sale.”

Continue along Pratts Rd for 7.34 km until you reach a T-junction. Turn left at the junction onto North Coast Road.

Reset your trip computer again and measure 10.39 km. Once you have gone this far you have reached Middle River Lookout. It will be on your right with a sign next to the gate.
